2. All patients will continue to be screened prior to being seen for their appointment.
3. Patients are encouraged to bring/wear a face mask to your appointments.
4. Only the patients will be allowed in the building for appointments, all other guests will be asked to wait in the car. If your guest is attending out of necessity that person will be required to undergo screening prior to entering the building as well.
5. Adhere to all social distancing guidelines as much as possible while in the office.

Please know that we continue to clean and disinfect properly after each patient and at the end of each day, we are also continuing to require our staff to take certain safety precautions as well.
